

Application Instructions **Book Fair Foundation Grant**

The Book Fair Foundation collects books throughout the year and sells them at our annual November sale. It is historically the largest used book sale in Ohio.

Net proceeds of the sale are divided among three beneficiaries. In the recent past, this amounts to awards of around \$10,000 each. If we have a wildly successful sale, the awards would be larger, and conversely, if it's not a good year for books, then more modest. Checks are presented after the sale, on February 2.

Here are a few important points to keep in mind.

You must have your own 501c3 designation from the Internal Revenue Service to apply. We understand great groups do good works out there operating under the umbrella of larger organizations, but we must have a baseline. If you don't have this designation from the IRS, we cannot consider your application.

Your organization must be incorporated within 25 miles of Dayton. It is important to us that the money we raise stays in our own community.

Two deadlines are posted each year. One deadline for a post-mark and one for hand-delivery. Please don't mail on the hand-delivery deadline! With your application, please include a one-page cover letter— your opportunity to really make the case for why we should choose your organization.

Beneficiaries are chosen by a group of seven (7) board members. Please provide seven (7) copies of your application. Supplemental materials are welcome- we'll need seven (7) copies of those as well. (However, if you want to include a flash drive with video or photographs of your organization's work, one will suffice.)

It is a Herculean effort to make the Book Fair happen, and we have an all-volunteer staff. To that end, we require 40 hours of volunteer effort on the part of each beneficiary. At least half of those hours must be fulfilled prior to the sale. We can organize a work day at the loft for a group, or a few individuals might help out through the year. Failure to complete the volunteer component could have unhappy consequences. This, and other considerations are spelled out in the letter we'll send you if your group is chosen. We love working with our beneficiaries and we've made lasting friendships through these partnerships.

The board meets several times during January to discuss the applications. It is remarkable to see how many fantastic non-profits there are in our community and what inspiring work you're all doing. It is very difficult to winnow down the choice to just three. Those chosen as beneficiaries will be notified via telephone in late January, with a letter to follow up. (Sad news comes via postcard.)
